

Learn How To Sail

Leland Yacht Club Sailing School Scholarship, provided by the Leland Yacht Club Foundation

The Leland Yacht Club Foundation (LYCF) is partnering with area schools to provide sailing instruction to local students between the ages of 8 and 12. Classes will take place at the Leland Yacht Club, located at 1221 Juniper Trail in Leland starting in mid June and continuing through early August; and recipients can elect to participate in as many weeks as they are available. Beginner classes are Tuesday through Friday from 9am to 12noon; and Advanced classes take place on Tuesday through Friday from 1pm to 3:30pm.

Apply Today

Together with school Administrators, LYCF will select recipients based on LYCF's Scholarship Policy criteria, including interest in learning to sail, enjoyment of water and the outdoors, character, resilience, and financial need. Family membership at Leland Yacht Club for summer 2025 will also be provided to the families of scholarship recipients. Applicants must be independent swimmers who are capable of passing a swim test, be a local student between the ages of 8 and 12 during summer of 2025, and reside in Leelanau County. Scholarships are renewable, so past recipients are strongly encouraged to re-apply. Applications will be confidential and are due no later than Friday March 21, 2025 so that recipients can be notified in April, shortly after spring break.
