

4-H TRACTOR SafetyProgram

For 14 and 15 Year Old Youth

Teens can improve their chances of employment this summer by completing a tractor safety training course!

Successful completion of a tractor operation safety course is required for all youth under the age of 16 who perform farm jobs classified as hazardous, under the U.S. Department of Labor's Hazardous Occupation Order.

To become certified, participants must attend all three course meetings, & pass an in-person written test and tractor driving test.

Who: Leelanau 4-H will host this training for 14 & 15 Year Old Youth. Youth must be age 14 by June 1st, 2025 Space is limited! (16 - 19 year olds are encouraged to participate, but priority is given to 14-15 year olds). Class curriculum follows Gearing Up for Safety: Production Agriculture Safety Training for Youth

Where: NW MI Horticulture Research Center, 6686 S. Center Hwy., Traverse City. (County Road 633 between Suttons Bay & Traverse City)

When: May 4th, May 18th & May 25th, from 3 to 5 p.m. An in-person written and driving test will be given on Sunday, June 1st* by appointment between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. (using SignUp Genius)

(*Rain date will be Sunday, June 8th.)

Cost: \$60 per person - includes: classes, manual, certificate, and snack on test day. Some scholarships are available if finances are an issue.
