

Sacraments Classes Sign Up Fall 2024

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) - This class is for older students and adults who may or may not have been baptized and wish to enter the Catholic Church. OCIA class time is TBD. Availability of students will determine the days and times the class will meet.

Sacramental Preparation (Sac Prep) - This course is intended for all 3rd grade students and older who have advanced from CF or St Mary 1 & 2 grade classes. This class is taught in conjunction with students receiving the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Communion and Confirmation. Students will continue studies on prayers, the Mass, names of items used during Mass and in church and what the Catholic Faith teaches us. Students will meet with Fr Ben and a parent-helper on Tuesdays from 3:30 pm-4:30 pm in the Social Hall.

Catholic Foundations (CF) - This course is intended for 1st & 2nd grade students not currently enrolled in St Mary School. This is an introductory class for young children which will introduce them to the Catholic Faith, basic daily & weekly prayers, the structure of the Holy Mass, names of items used during Mass and in church and more. Students will meet with a Catechist Instructor on Wednesdays from 3:30 pm-4:30 pm in the Social Hall.
