

## St. Mary School Pesticide Management Plan

This letter is to inform you of our Pesticide Management Plan. You have the right to request a notification by first-class U.S. mail at least three days before the application. Please indicate your desire and send back to school by September 1.

*Please note*, due to sanitization requirements for COVID-19, we must use disinfectants that are registered by the EPA (Environmental Protection Act) and listed as “pesticides.” Only teachers will use these disinfectants and will wear gloves while doing so. We are required to clean non-porous surfaces in the classrooms several times a day with these products. Our staff has been trained in how-to properly clean the surfaces and how-to respond if first aid is needed.

### **St. Mary Preschool Pesticide Management Plan**

The Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (1194 PA 451, MCL 324.8316) requires the following:

- An annual notice that pesticide application occurs in the building and on the premises. The annual notice will be in September of each year and state the two methods of notice that will be given prior to any application of pesticides. One notice must be a posting at entrance doors.
- Two methods of advance notice of application of pesticides anywhere on the premises of the child care center or school.
- Advance notice of least 48 hours prior to the application of pesticides.

St. Mary Preschool will post a notice on our door and provide a second form of notification by sending home a note with students to be delivered to their parent or guardian.
